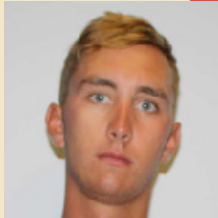


QUEENSBOROUGH STUDENT VETERANS RECIPIENTS OF THE FRIENDS OF VETERANS NEW YORK AWARD.
